

International Student Requirements for Course Entry

All places listed below are subject to availability

Primary Students:

The language of instruction at Alphington Grammar School is English. The philosophy of the school is to teach language acquisition through immersion, and due to this, the entry requirements for the Primary School are as follows:

Prep – Year 5

No test upon entry to the school is required

Year 6

It is preferred that all prospective Year 6 students undertake an AEAS test upon entry to the School. Before students are able to progress from Year 6 into Year 7, the minimum standard of achievement must be met. **In order to proceed to Year 7, students must achieve no lower than two-grid deviations below the lowest point of the five point scale in at least 4 subject areas** – two of which must be Mathematics and English. Students not achieving this minimum standard at the end of Year 6 will be asked to repeat the year level and will not progress to Year 7.

Secondary Students:

Before enrolment can be considered all students are required to submit school reports, and **MUST** submit an AEAS test. Consideration for entry is based on the following criteria:

Year 7 – 11:

AEAS Test Score: 42 – 50

Students may be offered 2 terms of High School Preparation Program (HSPP) at Alphington Grammar School. At the end of the program students must undertake a written and oral examination and achieve an 80% pass to obtain entry into mainstream classes.

Year 12:

Alphington Grammar does not offer student entry/enrolment into Year 12.
