

Scholarship Application Form: Music

Applications close on Friday 24 February 2023, at 4PM

Scholarships may be awarded to students who display exceptional talent in, and commitment to, the Performing Arts (Music).

Current and new students entering Year 5 to Year 10 in 2024 are eligible to apply for this scholarship. It is an expectation that scholarship recipients continue their studies in Music to Year 12. Recipients of this scholarship are also expected to participate in two music ensembles and contribute to school performances and events.

Scholarships awarded range as a percentage of School tuition costs for varying periods of time commencing in the year of entry. The amount will be determined on a case by case basis for each individual applicant. Please note: All consumables and other compulsory charges are payable at the relevant cost.

All applicants must submit a formal application to the Principal, **Dr Vivianne Nikou**, by the above date to be considered for the Scholarship.

In order to be considered for the scholarship, applicants must submit to The School:

- The completed application form
- The applicant's two most recent school reports
- The applicant's most recent NAPLAN results
- Payment of the \$60 application fee

Alphington Grammar School reserves the right to withhold a Scholarship if no suitable candidate fulfils the criteria as deemed appropriate by the Selection Committee. No correspondence pertaining to any individual's application or Scholarship will be entered into once The School has made its decision.

Successful applicants will be short-listed for an audition and interview with the Principal and Head of Music and Performing Arts. Short-listed applicants should come prepared to talk about their skills and attributes, and their suitability for selection.

Music Requirements:

Scholarships are granted to students on the basis of an audition and interview. The school requires the student to excel in their chosen instrument and demonstrate genuine commitment to the Performing Arts (Music).

To be short-listed and selected for an audition, students need to fulfil the following requirements:

AMEB or equivalent (at the discretion of the Head of Music):

Years 5-6	Grade 3 or higher in Piano, Grade 2 or higher in Strings, Grade 2 or higher in Wind, Brass, or Percussion.
Years 7-10	Grade 4 or higher in Piano, Grade 3 or higher in Strings, Grade 3 or higher in Wind, Brass, or Percussion.
Voice	Grade 2 or higher.
