2023 FEE SCHEDULE

Overseas students

1. Registration Fee: \$110 per student

The Registration fee (GST inclusive) is **non-refundable** and must accompany each single application. This fee is for the payment of administration costs incurred by the school for the processing of each student's application.

2. Confirmation Fee: \$1,250 per student

A **non-refundable** Confirmation Fee of AUD \$1,250 per student will be charged upon acceptance and prior to entry to Alphington Grammar School.

3. Homestay Fee

All students irrespective of age (with the exception of students under the age of 13 who must reside with a parent) must live in accommodation approved by The School.

Students will be assisted by the School's International Student Coordinator to arrange a Homestay host.

The indicative cost of Homestay is approximately \$AUD350 - \$AUD400 per week. Any changes to Homestay must be approved by The School prior to the student moving addresses.

4. Annual School Fees and Charges (*compulsory*)

All school fees are in AUD dollars.

5. Gateways Program: (Years 9 and 10 Students)

Years 9 and 10 students are required to participate in either the Gateway's Domestic or International Program. This is a compulsory activity that incurs an extra charge which is included in the Tuition fees. There is no refund for non-participation.

6. Building Levy

The \$995 Building Levy is a **compulsory charge** (non-tax deductible). The funds received through this levy assist The School with its ongoing buildings and facility improvements program.

7. Information Communication Technology Levy (ICT)

The ICT levy covers the provision of hardware, internet access, software licenses, management, and support to ensure that students have the most up to date ICT.

For Years 7-9: the laptop cost is included in this levy. From 2023 this cost will be added in full to the Year 7 ICT levy. For Years 8 and 9, 2023 will serve as a transition year in that the balance of the laptop cost is added to the levy. Any new students starting in Years 8 or 9 will be charged the full levy on commencement at the School.

8. Overseas Student Health Cover

The Australian Government requires all Full Fee-Paying Overseas Students to take out Overseas Student Health Cover” for the duration of their visa. **Alphington Grammar School arranges such cover before the student commences at the school.**

The indicative cost of compulsory Health cover is \$AUD 536 per annum and will be calculated by the school for the duration of the student visa.

9. Additional Instrumental Music Lessons

These are optional classes for students. For further information please refer to the School Instrumental Music Program Policy. These are charged at the rate of: \$1,774 per annum – for 32 individual music lessons.

10. School Books

School booklists for the school’s official book supplier is published on the School’s website.

11. School Uniform

School uniform is compulsory. An indicative cost of new uniform is approximately \$AUD730-\$AUD945. The school’s official uniform supplier is:

12. Personal Spending

Students find that approximately \$AUD75-AUD\$150 per week covers their spending needs for entertainment, transport, and personal needs. This of course is up to the individual preferences.

13. School Bus Fees

Full-time: \$3,500 per annum

Part-time minimum 50% usage calculated on a pro rate basis.

Part-time *less* 50% usage \$15.00 per trip.

14. School Fee Payment Date

Students' fees must be paid in full prior to the student commencement at the school. Annual school fees are billed in august and due for payment by 3 October of the preceding year.

15. Refund of Fees-International Business rules Section 3 and 4

If a student has paid fees in advance and is refused a Visa, then the school will refund the total advance course fee payment per section 3.1. Evidence of the visa application must be provided to the School.

The amount of refund of tuition fees in the event of provider default under subsection 47D of the Act, is calculated as follows: refund amount = weekly tuition fee × weeks in default period per section 4.

Should a student be withdrawn from enrolment before the student commences with the school then the refund will be made in terms of section 3.3 of the International Business rules.

A student being suspended or expelled from the school will not have their paid course fees refunded as per section 3.5.

Fee refunds will be made in Australian dollars payable only to the party making the original payment. (Refunds will not be made to the student).
