

2023 FEE SCHEDULE

Early Learning Centre (3 and 4 Year Old)

1. Registration Fee: \$110 per student

The Registration fee is **non-refundable** and is paid at the time of each application.

2. Confirmation Fee: \$1,250 per student

For each student enrolling, a **non-refundable** Confirmation Fee will be charged upon acceptance to Alphington Grammar School.

3. Terms of Payment

The payment of one tuition fee instalment in advance applies to all students. The first fee is payable in October of the preceding year.

4. Payment Due Dates

Account No. 1: due by 15 October 2022

Account No. 2: due by 10 February 2023

Account No. 3: due by 12 May 2023

Account No.4: due by 11 August 2023

*Fees are set each year by School Council and published in advance of the October account.

* Building Levy per family (2 or more children) \$1,896 per annum.

6. Tuition Fee Discounts

Sibling Discount: The sibling discount for tuition fees is calculated at a rate of 10% for the second child and 30% for the third and subsequent children in the family attending the school at the same time. The discounts do not apply to the first child or to students in receipt of any other discount or scholarship.

Full Fee Payment in Advance Discount: A 5% discount of the annual Tuition Fee will be applied to families who pay their full school fees in advance with the October Payment.

7. Consolidated Fee

The Consolidated Fee (compulsory charge) applicable to a particular year level is levied to cover

the cost of compulsory programs that form part of the curriculum and includes online subject memberships and subscriptions, compulsory camps, excursions and incursions, sport fees, Inter-house and Inter-school competitions, subject competitions, art supplies, classroom music, provision of classroom texts, photocopying, the supply of printed materials, Student ID Cards, Student Diaries, homework folders, School Magazine and Student Accident Insurance Protection.

Consolidated Fee *excludes* private music tuition.

8. Information Communication Technology Levy (ICT)

The ICT Levy covers the provision of support and access to onsite ICT. This includes networking infrastructure and hardware, software, licensing, internet access and connectivity and technical advice.

9. Building Levy

The Building Levy is a **compulsory charge** (non-tax deductible). The funds received through this levy assist the schools ongoing maintenance, capital development and improvement programs.

10. Building Fund Donation (tax-deductible)

The Building Fund Donation of \$750 per annum is a voluntary tax-deductible gift by each family to the school. The Alphington Grammar School Building Fund Assessment Act 1997 as a deductible gift receipt for the operation of such building fund and can be listed on your annual tax refund.

11. Late Fees

A late fee of \$250 per account is charged for each account when tuition fees are not paid by the due date.

12. Administration Fee

Any Credit Card, Direct Debit that is declined by the bank, for any reason, will attract an administrative fee of \$75 per declined transaction.

13. Methods of Fee Payment

Registration and Confirmation Fee payments can be made by:

- Credit Card (an additional 1% surcharge not processed online incl. GST),
- AMEX (an additional 1.5% surcharge).

Tuition Fee/ Consolidated Fee/ ICT Levy / Building Levy and all other fee account payment can be made by:

- Credit Cards (an additional 1% surcharge incurred if not processed online (incl. GST),
- B-Pay,
- Sentral Pay through the school portal
- AMEX (an additional 1.5% surcharge incurred).
