Dear Parents, Parent Liaisons and Year 10 students,

## **RE: Morrisby Profile**

As part of the Year 10 Careers Program, students will have the opportunity to complete the Morrisby Profile on Monday 15 May from 9.00 am. Students will need to have their device with them, making sure it is fully charged. This is not a test; The Morrisby Profile is a widely known service in careers guidance. The Profile (Myer Briggs) assesses aptitudes, learning and personal working styles, to inspire and help students to make informed decisions about their careers.

As well as taking an objective assessment of aptitudes, the profile will also take interests, working style and academic achievements into account to create a comprehensive, holistic, and individually tailored analysis on which to base future career and subject selection decisions.

## Who is it for?

Anyone aged 15 years and over can take the Morrisby Profile. Alphington Grammar School use the on-line Morrisby Profile to guide and inform students making their initial career and subject choices.

## How do we know it works?

The Morrisby Profile is regularly reviewed and registered by the Psychological Testing Centre (PTC), a division of the British Psychological Society (BPS). This provides objective and independent verification, to show that the Morrisby Profile not only works, but that it is valid and reliable in the way it measures and assesses candidate abilities.

Morrisby online is the perfect tool in school for students to allow them to develop confidence about their future plans. They become more self-aware, and they can research education pathways and careers to suit their interests and strengths. Students can tailor suggested careers to suit their personality, talents and/or aptitudes. Morrisby online is also the perfect tool to encourage discussion at home as parents can access their child's results and support them through option choices at 16 and 18 years of age. To be prepared to complete the Profile, I highly suggest that students have a look at the Practice Questions in the link below. Once completed the results will be emailed to students and to myself – I have been an accredited Morrisby Practitioner since 2013. We will book an appointment to discuss the profile and provide further guidance regarding subject choices for VCE, with particular reference to satisfying any prerequisites for university courses. Mr. Silver will be sending out additional information about the Subject Information Expo taking place on June 5. All Heads of Faculty will present their subjects to the Year 10 students during this expo to help them in the subject selection process for VCE.
