### **Eligibility Criteria**

Candidates applying for the 2025 Performing Arts (Music) Scholarship must enter Years 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 or 10 in 2025. It is an expectation that scholarship recipients:

- continue their studies in the Performing Arts (Music) to Year 12, and
- participate in two music ensembles annually and contribute to a full range of school performances and events.

- 2023 Semester 2 Report (Terms 3 & 4)
- Most recent NAPLAN results
- Any other relevant supporting documentation (e.g. AMEB results)
- Proof of payment of a non-refundable \$60 scholarship application fee. Payment to be made by Humanitix.

#### **The Evaluation Process**

To be shortlisted and invited for an audition, students must meet the following minimum requirements from AMEB examinations or equivalent (at the discretion of the Head of Music).

Years 5-6	Grade 3 or higher in Piano, Grade 2 or higher in Strings, Grade 2 or higher in Wind, Brass or Percussion.
Years 7-10	Grade 4 or higher in Piano, Grade 3 or higher in Strings, Grade 3 or higher in Wind, Brass or Percussion.
Voice	Grade 2 or higher.

Successful candidates will be short-listed and invited for an audition and personal interview with the Principal and the Head of Music and Performing Arts.
