RE: Primary House Cross Country Carnival 2024 Prep - Year 6

The Alphington Grammar School Primary House Cross Country Carnival will be held on **Tuesday 26 March** from 11.00am – 3pm. This program will again be held here on our school oval and on parts of the Darebin Creek Trail (Years 3 – 6 only).

The House Carnival will include all students from **Prep – Year 6**. The program will be split in two parts with the Prep – Year 2 program running from 11.00am – 12.30pm. The Years 3 - 6 Program will run from 1.30 – 3.00pm.

Event Times:

o **Prep:** 800m – 11.10am

Year 1 + Year 2: 1.5km - 11.30am
Year 3/4 students: 2km - 1.30pm

○ **Year 5 + Year 6 students**: 3km – 1.50pm

All students 3 - 6 are to attend school in their House colour uniforms. Prep – 2 can either wear their House colour tops or a T-shirt in the colour of their House (Aristotle - Blue, Byron - Yellow, Pericles - Red, Socrates - Green) as an alternative to the House top.

If you plan on attending, please enter the school via the reception gate and make your way down to the school car park located on top of the oval. Please note you will need to sign in with the allocated staff member at the school car park. This is a necessary measure to ensure the safety and security of all students and staff. From there, you will have a great view of the event and can cheer on your child and their classmates.

We would like to remind you of the importance of safety on school grounds. Therefore, we kindly ask that all parents stay off the oval and tennis courts during the event and watch from the designated car park area.

While we understand that you may want to get as close as possible to the action, it is essential that we maintain a safe and secure environment for our young athletes and staff.
