Year 7 Hellenic Museum Excursion

As part of our coursework and study of Greek language and culture in our Greek classes and of Ancient Greek history in our Humanities classes, a visit to the Hellenic Museum in Melbourne has been organised for Tuesday 6 August (7A & 7C) and Thursday 8 August (7B & 7D) between 9.00am – 1.00pm. Students will travel to and from the Museum by train and will be accompanied by their teachers. A Myki card will be required.

Students will enjoy an interactive workshop on the Olympic games and a guided tour of the museum to explore 8,000 years of Hellenic history through the various artefacts on display in the 'Gods, Myths and Mortals' exhibit. The exhibit includes objects from the Minoan era, through the Mycenean Civilisation, the Hellenistic period, the Byzantine Empire and the Greek Revolution of 1821. Students are expected to be in full winter uniform, including blazer.

They will need to bring with them a pen or pencil; a small bottle of water and lunch/snack.
