

Overseas Student Requirements for Course Entry

All places listed are subject to availability.

1. Primary Students:

- 1.1. The language of instruction at Alphington Grammar School is English. The philosophy of the school is to teach language acquisition through immersion, and due to this, the entry requirements for the Primary School are as follows:

Prep – Year 3	No test upon entry to the school is required. However, an interview with the Head of School is required to determine language proficiency.
Year 4 – 6	AEAS Test Score: 46 and above It is a requirement that all prospective Years 4 – 6 students undertake an AEAS test prior to entry to the School. To progress from Year 6 into Year 7, the minimum standard of achievement must be met. Students must obtain a test average of 60% .

2. Secondary Students:

- 2.1. Before enrolment can be considered all students are required to submit school reports, and **MUST** submit an AEAS test. Consideration for entry is based on the following criteria:

Year 7 – 10	AEAS Test Score: 70 and above After an assessment of student reports and other data, students may be offered an interview with the Head of School.
Year 11	Alphington Grammar School does not offer student entry/enrolment into Year 11.
Year 12	Alphington Grammar School does not offer student entry/enrolment into Year 12.
